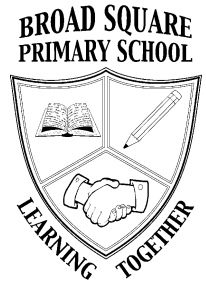

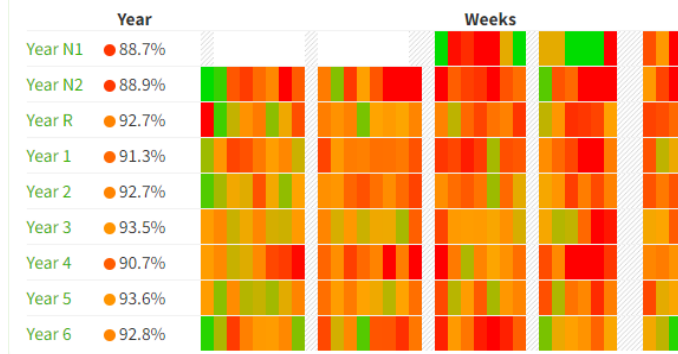
Attendance

New Covid Rules

As of 1st April, Covid rules for schools change again. Here is a summary of the new arrangements:

- If your child has a positive test, they must isolate for **3 days**. If they still have a high temperature after this period, they must stay off school until their temperature returns to normal.
- If your child has not tested positive (i.e. because there are no tests available to check) but has a high temperature, they must remain off school until their temperature returns to normal.
