I am sorry to say we have finished the half term with a very poor overall attendance figure, largely due to holidays in term time and illness. Messages have been sent / will be sent out to all parents of children who are currently classed as PA (Persistent Absentee, attendance under 90%), inviting you in for a meeting with our attendance team to see what we can do to help support you to improve your child's attendance. Every time a child is absent from school they miss crucial learning with there being a direct link between low attendance and low attainment. I know that every parent wants the best for their child, helping them to achieve their full potential. We look forward to seeing an improvement next half term, have a lovely rest.

Start of school day

I understand that there has been confusion about the timings for the start of the school day. I appologise for any confusion that may have been caused and appreciate how hard it is for parents and carers who have been dealing with regular changes over the past couple of years. Government guidelines state that we have to do a specific amount of hours within our school week. To meet this target we must start our school day at **8:45am** and finish at **3:20pm**.
