## Parents evening

As this is new guidance, children will still be able to wear their blue dresses from this year if they still fit as I do not want any additional cost for families. However, the blue dresses are to be phased out for **red dresses**.























## **Children in Need**

Children in need is on **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November** and we will be celebrating this is school. A letter and sponsor form will be going out with the children. Children can wear own **'sporty clothes'** for a £1 donation, or they can wear their school PE kit. The children will be collecting sponsor money for completing a 'crazy assault course' in school. We recognise the financial stress on families now and we only ask for what people can afford.
