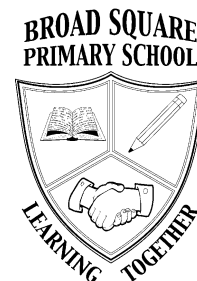

Year 6 SATS

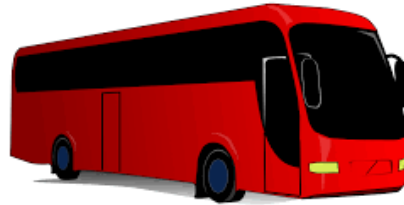

Snacks

Can I remind Junior children that mid-morning snack is only a piece of **fruit or vegetable**. We are seeing children eat inappropriate snacks such as large chocolate bars or muffins. This is not necessary or appropriate. As we are a healthy school we will continue to encourage and support our children to make healthy choices.

Water bottles



We encourage children to bring water bottles into school so that they can stay hydrated throughout the school day. However, we ask that only water comes into school. No juice. We do have cups available for children and access to water throughout the day.

Summer Uniform

We are in summer term now and children are welcome to wear their summer uniform (if they choose). Just a reminder that the only difference is that shorts can be worn instead of trousers and red gingham dresses can be worn. Children should still wear their maroon jumpers or cardigans and **black school shoes or plain black trainers**. **Jelly sandals are not part of our school uniform and they are not suitable footwear for children to wear all day in school, especially when they are running around at playtime.**

I hope that all of our children, families and staff have a wonderful half term break. Thank you for all of your support and friendship this half term. I am already looking forward to welcoming all of our children safely back to school after the half term break on **Monday 5th June**.
