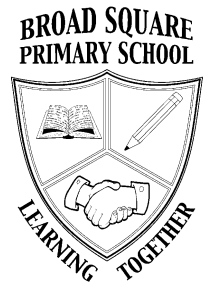

Year 1 Phonics

Our wonderful year 1 pupils have all completed their phonics screening check. The children have done fantastically well. They are the best results that Broad Square has had in a number of years and we are very proud of all of our year 1 children. Parents will get these results within their end of year reports.

Year 2 assessment checks

We were visited by an external moderator last week who checked all of year 2 work. They were very impressed with how hard our children had been working. Another success for team Broad Square!

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Snacks and water

Messages stay the same around healthy snacks (junior children) and water bottles. For junior children mid-morning snack is only a piece of **fruit or vegetable**.
