## In Mathematics...

We will work with numbers up to 10,000,000, understanding place value and developing skills in comparing, ordering and rounding, along with addition and subtraction using place value. We will improve our problem solving skills and work with negative numbers, multiples, prime, square and cube numbers.



## In Science...

We will explore the idea of how light travels in straight lines and how we see things that are reflected into our eyes. We will also look at how light is refracted when it travels through water.



## In Geography...

The children will look at the state of California and the reasons why it is so dry. They will look at the water cycle, farming and agriculture.

## In P.E...

We will learn to react positively to improve performance and develop ball skills and agility.



## In English...

Whilst reading about Rose Blanche and Anne Frank will work on developing a range of different sentence types in order to write a diary extract and bravery speech award. Daily reading will help us to develop our fluency, understanding and love of literature. Handwriting, spelling, grammar teaching is a constant focus to help support our writing development.
