Look at Y6's learning adventure this half term.

In Mathematics...

We will develop our skills and knowledge of fractions, including: finding equivalent fractions; comparing fractions; adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers: multiplying and dividing fractions; finding fractions of amounts.

Use and interpret metric and imperial units of measure.

In French...

Be more fluent in recalling numbers up to 100 in French through stories and games.

In Music...

Children will learn about songs from World War 2, and their historic significance. They will learn to sing songs in two or more parts from memory.

In Science...

We will explore electricity; associate brightness of bulb with the voltage of cells. Compare and give reasons when investigating and use symbols to create a circuit diagram.

In English...

Whilst reading about refugees, we will work on developing a range of different sentence types in order to write a flashback narrative and newspaper report. Daily reading will help us to develop our fluency, understanding and love of literature . Handwriting, spelling, grammar teaching is a constant focus to help support our writing development.

Art/Design Technology

We will explore textiles and develop our use of different stitches to join and embellish fabric. Our designer in focus is Susan Kare.

INR.E...

Children will earn about the religion of Islam.

In Geography...

Children will learn about Migration; what it is, why people migrate, how it changes places and refugees.

Through the theme of World War Two learn how a war so far away affected our city and the people within it.


