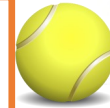


Look at Reception's learning adventure this term....

In Mathematics...

We will be counting, comparing and subitising numbers up to 5. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes.

We will have a variety of mathematical activities in our classroom and outdoor space to reinforce learning.



In literacy...

Begin to read individual letters by saying the sounds for them. Begin to form recognisable letters e.g. letters from their name, some of which are formed correctly
