In Mathematics...

We will be counting, comparing, subitising and combining numbers up to 10. We will also be looking at measure (length, height, and distance).

We will have a variety of mathematical activities in our classroom and outdoor space to reinforce learning.



In literacy...

We will continue to read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.

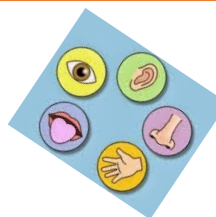
We will begin to blend sounds into words, so that we can read short words, phrases and sentences.

We will begin to write short words and sentences with known letter-sound correspondences. We will continue to practise writing letters correctly.

In phonics...

Through our engaging Monster Phonics scheme we will learn and practice sounds every day. We will also focus on the digraphs: oo, ow, ee, ur and ai.

In Expressive Arts and Design

We will develop storylines in our pretend play. We will continue to explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express our ideas and feelings. We will explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.
