In Mathematics...

Daily retrieval practise will help us to recall our learning from previous units.

We will continue our work on fractions, decimals and percentages. Children will build their fluency, as well as honing their reasoning and problem solving skills. Children will also learn about Area and Perimeter.



In English...

We will be enjoying the book *Origin of a Species* and will be writing a discovery narrative inspired by Charles Darwin. We love reading and practising our grammar and punctuation and spelling every day and are developing our handwriting and presentation.

In Science...
