In Mathematics...

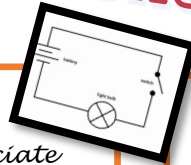
We will develop our skills and knowledge of fractions, including: finding equivalent fractions; comparing fractions; adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers; multiplying and dividing fractions; finding fractions of amounts.

Use and interpret metric and imperial units of measure.



In Science...

We will explore electricity; associate brightness of bulb with the voltage of cells. Compare and give reasons when investigating and use symbols to create a circuit diagram.

Improve skills in swimming along with a weekly PE session, focusing on balancing on a line and counter balancing with a partner.



In English...

We will be looking at the stories of 'Rose Blanche' and 'Anne Frank', writing emotive diary entries and bravery speeches showing our increasing control of tone and formality. This will jigsaw with our History unit on WW2. Our class reader is 'War Horse' to build our background knowledge of WW1.
