In Mathematics...

Sing/say numbers

Recognise numbers through play

Cardinal principle

Begin to match amounts to numerals

Literacy

Children will develop their communication language and vocabulary through daily NELI-N sessions

Develop understanding of books, what print means, develop phonological awareness and more!

In phonics...

Children to take part in daily Monster Phonics sessions that focus on Phase 1 phonics.

PSE Development

Develop knowledge of different resources and how to use them, show respect and responsibility for things, develop friendships, become familiar with adults in the setting, become more out-going in social situations.

Communication and Language

We will listen to a range of stories. Develop our understanding of a question, sing a range of songs, listen to rhymes and develop our communication skills.. Support all children using

Expressive Arts and Design

Home learning

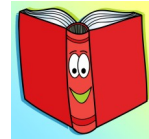
Use Evidence Me regularly
