Literacy

Daily NELI-N sessions
Start to write some letters of their name
Write some other letters accurately
Develop phonetical awareness, spotting rhymes, counting syllables, recognise words with initial sounds.

Understanding the World

Use their senses to explore materials, talk about what they see and explore how things work.

Outdoor learning

Exploring our outdoor space, taking part in child initiated and adult led activities.

Other activities

Expressive Arts and Design
