



Look at Reception's learning adventure this term.....

In Mathematics...

We will be learning about measure (weight), number bonds to 10, subtraction, and exploring patterns.

We will have a variety of mathematical activities in our classroom and outdoor space to reinforce learning.



In literacy...

We will continue to blend sounds into words, so that we can read short words, phrases and sentences. We will continue to write short words and sentences with known letter-sound correspondences using a capital letter and a full stop. We will continue to practise forming lower-case and upper-case letters correctly.



In Understanding the World...

Through our topic of 'People Who Help Us' we will explore our local area and talk about members of our community and the jobs they may do. We will also be learning about seasonal change and spring.



In phonics...

Through our engaging Monster Phonics scheme we will learn and practise sounds every day. We will also focus on the digraphs: or, oa, er, oi, and the trigraphs: igh, air.



In Expressive Arts and Design

We will develop storylines in our pretend play. We will develop skill in exploring, using and refining a variety of artistic effects to express our ideas and feelings. We will explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Through Jigsaw we will be exploring 'Healthy Me, and learning about exercising our bodies, physical activity, healthy food, sleep, keeping clean, and safety.
