In phonics...

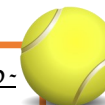

In Physical Development

We will be developing our small motor skills so that we can use a range of tools confidently.

We will continue to blend sounds into words, so that we can read simple phrases and sentences. We will continue to write short words and sentences with known letter-sound correspondences using a capital letter and a full stop. We will begin to read and recognise a few common exception words.

We will explore and engage in music making and dance, performing in groups with encouragement.

We will create collaboratively; sharing ideas, resources and skills.
