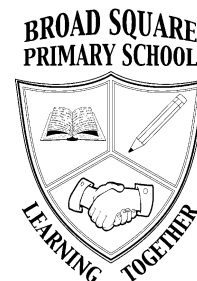

Start of school day

I understand that there has been confusion about the timings for the start of the school day. I apologise for any confusion that may have been caused and appreciate how hard it is for parents and carers who have been dealing with regular changes over the past couple of years. Government guidelines state that we have to do a specific amount of hours within our school week. To meet this target we must start our school day at **8:45am** and finish at **3:20pm**.

In the morning, you can come onto the yard from 8:40am and doors will open at **8:45am** for children to come straight in.
